



- Financial Assistance to help ease any financial burdens from the point of accident until Workers Comp or Insurances pay out. This Assistance generally pays anywhere from 0-12 months.
- Physical Assistance: Our fantastic members Nationwide volunteer their time to assist the family directly. This assistance includes late night phone calls, delivering home cooked meals, helping with household chores, etc.
- · Emotional Assistance: We have an on staff clinical licensed Therapist who donates sessions to the families for counseling, grieving, etc.
- Scholarships: When age appropriate, Children of Fallen Linemen may apply for College Scholarships. These Scholarships are renew able every year they attend school.
