Our 9th annual Fallen Lineworkers Benefit Rodeo will be held on **Saturday, June 19th** at our new, permanent NSUJL Rodeo Grounds at **555 Foster Ave., Freeland, PA 18224**.

WARDUT EFLL

Each June, on the eve of their annual Rodeo, NSUJL and Climbing For Lost Linemen hold a ceremony honoring all brothers who lost their lives on the line during the prior 12 months. This year, $CFLL^{TM}$ will be held on **Friday, June 18th, 2021** on our new Rodeo grounds.

The CFLL™ ceremony takes place at dusk and is a tribute that cannot be described in words – but by the chills and tears on the faces of our fellow brothers and sisters. A lantern is raised with each fallen brother's name etched on it, as a brother climbs the pole to hang it and light the candle within. A moment of silence then takes place in the honoree's memory. This event is by far the most symbolic of all we do, and why we do it. At the conclusion of the Rodeo, Lanterns are then given and/or mailed to the families of those honored.
